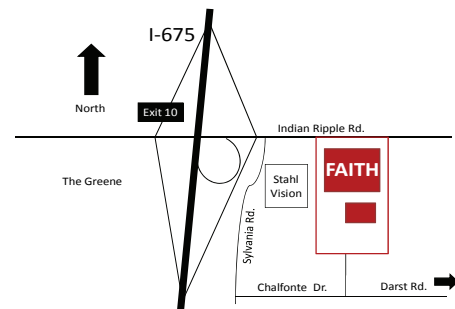

HOW CAN I GO TO HEAVEN?

Believe on the Lord Jesus Christ and thou shalt be saved...
Acts 16:31

1 ALL HAVE SINNED

For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God;

Romans 3:23

But your iniquities have separated between you and your God...

Isaiah 59:2



Sin is deliberately disobeying God and his plan for your life. Since the dawning of time when man first chose to sin against God, sin has plagued all mankind thus causing a separation between holy God and sinful man.

2 SIN HAS A PENALTY

For the wages of sin is death; but the gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord.

Romans 6:23

Ezekiel 18:4

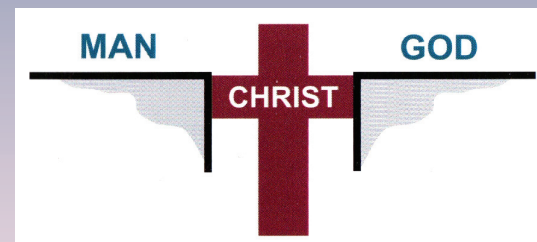
4 JESUS CHRIST PAID FOR OUR SINS

But God commendeth his love toward us, in that, while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us.

Romans 5:8

For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life.

John 3:16



The Bible shows us that in order for our sin debt to be paid, God had to provide a way to Himself. So God sent His son Jesus Christ to be born a man, live a sinless life and die in man's place. God's amazing love to man was displayed in the death, burial and resurrection of Jesus.

5 YOU CAN RECEIVE JESUS CHRIST AS YOUR SAVIOR

That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved.

For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation.
Romans 10:9-10

Receiving Jesus Christ as your Savior means to trust Him and totally depend on Him for your salvation. You must believe that He died for your sin, was buried and rose from the dead according to the Bible. Trusting in and receiving Jesus as your Savior is a personal act between you and God.

Simply pray and ask Jesus to come into your life, forgive your sin, and give you eternal life through his work on the cross and victory over death.
